## September 14 — Tie-Dye T-Shirts

Decorate the library interior windows with pixel art of your favorite characters made from post-it notes.

## October 26 — Pumpkin Carving

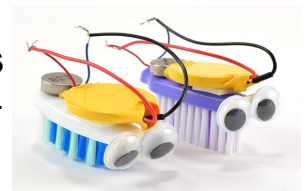


## November 9 — Rice Crispy Treat Bake-Off
