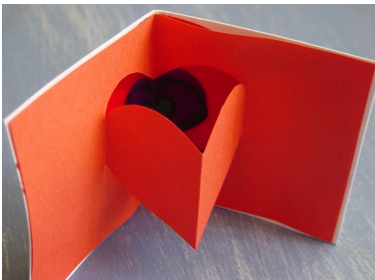


January 12 — Light Photography

January 26 — T-shirt Mods

February 2 — Cards & Cupcakes

Hand-mold your own creation from plastimake, a material that is clay-like for molding, but dries as hard plastic.
