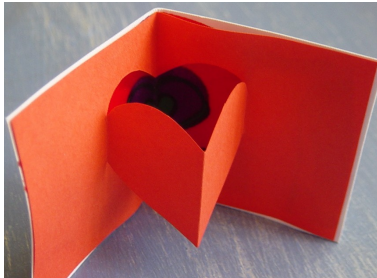


January 11 — Crochet a Scarf
