How you play:

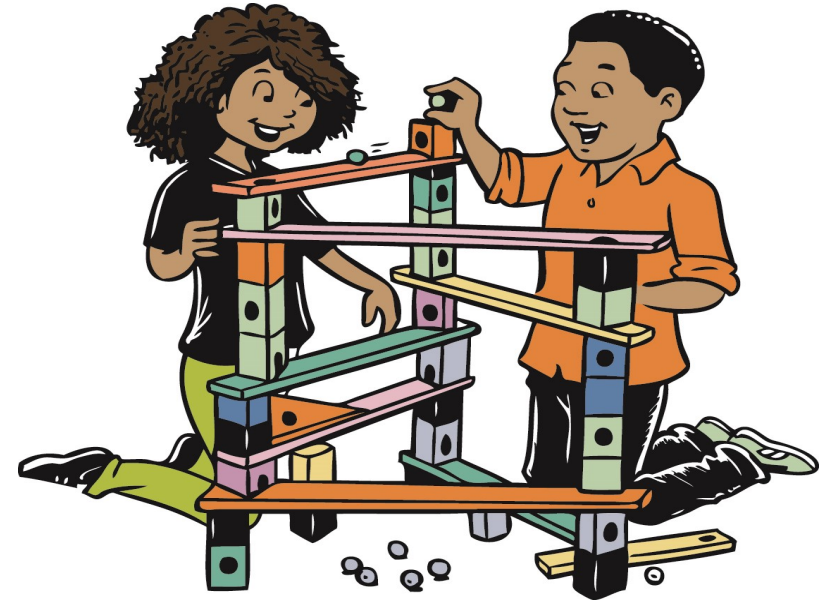
1. Beginning the day school is out on June 15, children ages 5 and up can pick up a Reading Record in the Children’s Department or online at www.guilfordfreelibrary.org.
2. You must register with us to get credit for the books you read and challenges you complete all summer. You may do this online, by phone, or in person.
3. Pick out a free book just for signing up!
4. Write your name on the Reading Record. You write the titles of the books you’ve read in the Record.
5. Sign up for the optional online game portion of our summer reading game, called Wandoo Reader, either in person or on our website. You may keep track of books you read, challenges you complete, and customize your explorer character.
6. Complete optional challenges to unlock secret codes online. Complete all the challenges for a special prize.
7. After you’ve read 10 books, bring your log to the library and show it to children’s room staff to get a game piece with your name on it. Put it on the lobby bulletin board, for all to see.
8. You have completed the game after reading 10 books.
9. Ask for a Final Certificate, then play again and pick up another Reading Record. You get an additional sticker for your game piece for every 10 books read.
10. The Summer Reading Game ends on August 31, the day school begins.
11. Take your Reading Record(s) to school this fall to show your teacher.
